

Request for the Provision of Theses to the Academic Institutional Repository

Toyohashi University of Technology Academic Institutional Repository is a repository of wisdom and an information transmission service designed to gather, electronically accumulate and archive academic research results electronically including journal articles produced at this university, and make them available for free public access on the Internet. The university has archived academic research results on the JAIRO Cloud of National Institute of Informatics (NII) and transmitted information from there.



About one year has passed since we officially opened the repository in February 2013. Currently, doctoral theses, bulletin papers in Hibarino and papers published in academic journals are being registered in stages.

We make them available for free public access on the Internet and transmit information. At the end of March 2016, the number of registered theses totaled 1,762, total browsing reached 45,184, and total downloading stood at 37,312.

We will try to gather and register more papers published in academic journals, including foreign journals. We ask for your cooperation in providing your theses and papers. ⇒ See the next page for registration (how to provide theses)

Academic research results that can be registered to Institutional Repository

- Academic research results generated by current or past Faculty Members and graduate school students of this university.
- Types of academic research results:
All types are accepted, including papers on academic journals, bulletin papers, theses, articles on general magazines, presentation, papers for meetings, presentation materials for meetings, books, research papers, preprints, educational materials, data, databases, and software.

About copyright

- Copyright owned by the author or the publisher of academic research results are maintained. Registering at the Institutional Repository does not mean the transfer of copyright.
- The university registers academic research results with the permission from copyright holder to register and disclose at Institutional Repository.
- If a publisher holds copyright, the library will confirm with the publisher whether it consents to registration at Institutional Repository in advance.

How to register in the Institutional Repository

In case of Papers on academic journals

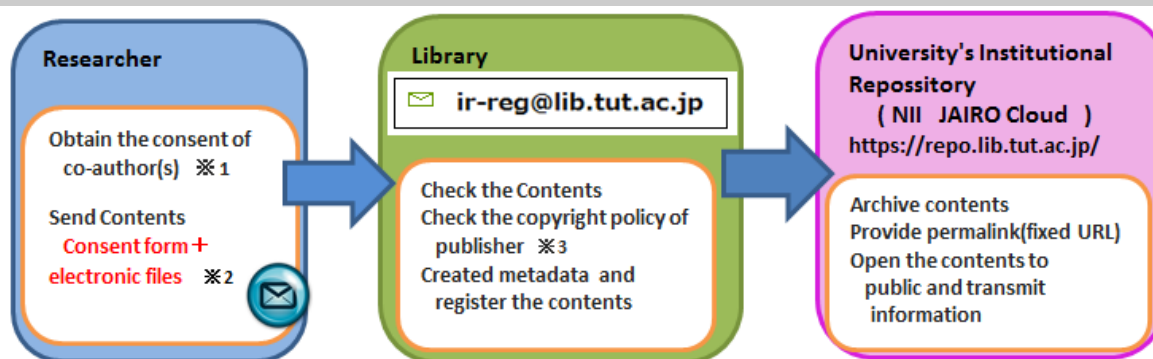
To register, send a Registration Consent Form and an electronic file of your academic research results to:

 ir-reg@lib.tut.ac.jp

(Exclusive e-mail address for sending electronic contents).

The Registration Consent Form can be downloaded from the “Registration Consent Form” of the contents registration method (https://repo.lib.tut.ac.jp/?page_id=31) on the Institutional Repository website.

The library will perform the registration process. Just send us the Registration Consent Form and electronic files.



【Points to be noted when sending an e-mail】

- ※1 If copyright is held by the author or the co-author(s), obtain the consent of the co-author(s) in advance before sending the contents. If a publisher or an academic society holds copyright, the consent of the co-author is not necessary.
- ※2 If the file is too large, you can store the data in a CD-ROM or a USB file and send the medium. Consult the library if you have printed materials (reprinted articles or journals). Any format is accepted (Word, PowerPoint, pdf, etc.). If your deliverables consist of multiple files (body text and illustrations), send the deliverables in their entirety. The library will convert them into pdf files before registration.
- ※3 The library will check the copyright policy of the publisher before registration.

Many foreign publishers including Elsevier and Springer allow the registration of post-prints (final draft post-refereeing) in the Institutional Repository.

How to register a doctoral thesis

The disclosure of doctoral theses on the Internet became mandatory for those who obtained a doctoral degree in April 2013 or later. For details, refer to: “Information from the Library.”

For those who obtained a doctoral degree by March 2013 and consent to the registration of the doctoral thesis on the Institutional Repository, send a Registration Consent Form and an electronic file of your thesis. If an electronic file is not available, the library will create a pdf file for registration from the doctoral thesis archived in the library.

- Pre-print allowed on any website or open access repository
- Voluntary deposit by author of authors post-print allowed on institutions open scholarly website including Institutional Repository, without embargo, where there is not a policy or mandate
- Deposit due to Funding Body, Institutional and Governmental policy or mandate only allowed where separate agreement between repository and the publisher exists.
- Permitted deposit due to Funding Body, Institutional and Governmental policy or mandate, may be required to comply with embargo periods of 12 months to 48 months.
- Set statement to accompany deposit
- Published source must be acknowledged
- Must link to journal home page or articles' DOI
- Publisher's version/PDF cannot be used
- Articles in some journals can be made Open Access on payment of additional charge
- NIH Authors articles will be submitted to PubMed Central after 12 months

Benefits of registering academic research results in the Institutional Repository

✓ Increase the visibility and citation index of papers

Papers registered in the Institutional Repository are not only available for direct search on the Institutional Repository website but also search engines such as Google and Google Scholar, as well as article information search sites including CiNii, JAIRO and OAIster. Making your paper accessible for free on the Internet enables browsing of the contents of papers without subscribing to expensive magazines. This is expected to increase the exposure of papers to researchers around the world, thereby increasing the citation index.

Looking at the case below, the usage statistics reveal that the thesis is being browsed from outside Japan.

✓ Achieve university's accountability and share research results with society

Registered papers are not only accessible by university researchers, but also corporate researchers and general users. Registration fulfills the university's accountability to society, and increases opportunities to share the university's state-of-the-art technologies with local communities. It also contributes to the university's public relations.

✓ Management and permanent storage of research results

Electronic data tend to be scattered and are difficult for individuals to manage systematically. Such data are archived and managed on the JAIRO Cloud server of the National Institute of Informatics (NII).

A permalink (a permanent URL that points to a specific web page is transferred or retired) will be given, allowing indefinite storage and disclosure even after the user transfers or retires from the university. In addition, DOIs will be given in the future.

A specific permalink is given for each thesis.
